#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**



Thank you for attending The Mass Arts Center's production of *Cabaret!* It has been eye-opening and inspiring to work on this iconic musical at such a time as this. *Cabaret* is a tall order at any time, but working on it now has been especially telling, and perhaps not for the reasons you might assume. Theatre presents, for better or worse, what is on the page. It doesn't make pretty or ugly look otherwise, unless otherwise has an artistic purpose. *Cabaret* is a musical set amidst a dark backdrop that invites us to deny terror and then harkens us to resist it. Thankfully it does so with a

dynamic musical score and a bevy of outstanding dance numbers.

This seminal work thrusts its audience into the decadent and dangerous world of the Kit Kat Klub, as 1929 turned into 1930 in Berlin, Germany. The Kit Kat Dancers, led by an alluring master of ceremonies, present social commentary on the real lives of Kander & Ebb's vulnerable and susceptible characters as they navigate their own world, as fascism is taking over the world around them. Inside the Kit Kat Club, the world is recognized as a place where everyone is encouraged to "leave their troubles outside," while those outside the Kit Kat Klub, doing their best to make ends meet, and perhaps enjoy some simple comforts and possible companionship along the way. Two dynamically distinct worlds enduring the same circumstances... in their own way. Parody vs. Reality. Denial vs. Acceptance. Survival vs. Risk. One thing is for sure. There is no easy answer to the challenges these characters bear any more than there are easy answers to the challenges we bear.

So, while you take in what some might describe as a cautionary tale, go ahead and leave your troubles outside, enjoy the iconic songs, sexy dances, and bawdy humor. There will be plenty of time for ... your consideration.

Theatre opens us up to culling through material with a fine-tooth comb. Theatre challenges our assumptions and encourages us to see a story through the experiences of others. To consider before judging. To empathize even with those with whom we do not agree. It is in the theatre where others are asked and allowed to answer, "What Would You Do?"

We want to thank the courage and commitment of this cast. We have been moved by the conversations this piece and rehearsal process have inspired, and we are humbled by the historic reminders that can serve us in the here and now.

And now .... Willkommen!
